After a while, perhaps even while there was Sunday School after service, sometimes I didn't eat to play the electric guitar because I didn't have one at home, and one day while I was playing, Kuya John Ross approached me and asked me invited to join the music team, and I because at that time we didn't know each other very well and I was ashamed so I said maybe then after some time had passed, I was playing on stage again and Kuya Kenneth approached me and spoke to me and also he had invited me to join the music team but we still didn't know each other very well and I was ashamed so I said "I'll think about it". Good morning to all of you, to those who don't know me, I'm Adam Mijares and I'm 17 years old.

I haven't been attending church here in Bruni for so long, my friends invited me to DVBS 2022. I went because almost all my friends at that time were going and since that summer, I can't do anything because if I don't I will be left alone. We are often outside because of volleyball or basketball or just wandering around.

After a few weeks of DVBS, Aunt Eunice & Aunt Arlene encouraged me to join the YOUTH CAMP (so that I can accept Jesus in my life.) I rarely go to church and pray that's why I went. Then at my youth camp, he accepted Jesus in my life because I really felt that the Lord loved me very much and I understood that God has a good plan for all of us.

After that I started coming here to church every time to worship Jesus and I also learned to pray every day for my family, friends, at school and in times of trouble.

Year 2020 was a really hard year for me and I know it was hard for all of us.

It was difficult for me because I experienced losing loved ones during that time.



February 2020 my aunt died in Dubai. COVID was not so widespread then so my dad and one sister were able to go home. I left me, my brother and my mother here in Italy. The lockdown reached them 3 days before their flight, so they were able to return in July. Dad's stomach

started hurting in August, we all thought it was just a normal pain that could be treated with medicine. After a few days, we sent her to the hospital to be checked up, but they said there was nothing to worry about, so she was sent home. Papa didn't know, when he was in the

hospital, grandfather was also in the hospital because his stomach hurt and he was having trouble breathing. August 15 grandfather couldn't take it anymore and died. A few days after dad came home from the hospital, the medicine the doctor gave him didn't seem to be helping and dad's condition seemed to get worse so we sent him to the hospital again, I was sad because I didn't have dad with me on my birthday.

August 25. The day after my birthday the hospital called and said my dad was gone. Dad was my number 1 supporter so it was really hard for me to accept that he was gone. But since I've been coming here every week, I feel better, especially since I accepted Jesus in my life.

I am very grateful to the Lord for his help to me, especially to my family because I feel like I

have become the man of the house with the Lord's help.

So I want to give God all the glory and praise for everything he has done for me-my family and for what he will do.
